Present: Terry Fleck, Cary Backstrand, Bruce McCollom, Gordon Weixel, Ken Royse, Michael Gunsch, HEI, Dave Bliss, Bliss & Stebbins Law Firm, Mona Livdahl, Personalized Management Services, Inc.

Chairman Fleck called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. noting a quorum was present

Minutes: Cary moved to approve the Minutes of November 7, 2012, Bruce seconded. Motion carried.

Financials: Provided as a handout, Ken reviewed no action taken.

Approval of Bills: Noted the Parks & Rec bill was provided after the briefing book was mailed out, a handout was provided with the revision. Bruce moved to approve the bills as revised in the amount of \$40,035.08, Gordon seconded. Motion carried.

McDowell Dam:

Greg reported that the switch for dates of ice on ice off fishing periods has been working. Chairman Fleck noted we had received an evaluation on Bobcat to fill out, this was provided to Greg Smith to complete.

North Dakota Spaniel Club: Rodney Beck, Program Director was present to request a special us of the facility. The ND Spaniel Club y requested to use McDowell Dam for the water portion of their 2013 National English Cocker Spaniel Championship October 22-26, 2013. It was noted that if it is approved by this Board, we would need authorization from the Bismarck Parks and Recreation District regarding using rifles even though they are blanks and having dogs off leash and clean up. It was noted that a letter would need to be sent to the managing director at the Bismarck Parks and Rec District to get these concerns addressed and authorized. Mr. Beck noted that they would have people taking care of clean up and assisting in the process. Cary moved to let the ND Sporting Club use the lake with the provision that they first write a letter to the Bismarck Parks and Recreation to obtain their approval on the deviation from the park rules. Bruce seconded. Motion carried.

Water Permit: Nothing new to report at this point. Cary noted he is still trying to work with the State Water Commission (SWC) to get this permit approved. Noted this has been on file with the SWC since around 2008 and they are short staffed and doing work on priority levels.

Drainage Complaints:

Bittner/Smith/Barbere: Noted the Bitner portion of this complaint is done and we are just working with the Smith/Barbere portion as needed. The roadway ditch has been cleaned. A number of ideas were provided to Mr. Smith and Mr. Barber as to what can be done to address the noted concerns. Cary noted it is now between the landowners as to the final solution.



Eldin Speirs: Cary noted that he met with the Mel Bullinger, Bismarck City Engineer and other City staff on this issue and they will be contacting United Tribes Technical College (UTTC) regarding the complaint. Part of the problem is the retention area doesn't have adequate storage capacity given high groundwater and it then overflows onto Mr. Speirs property. Michael noted he visited with Linda Oster and Mel Bullinger and they are in the process of drafting the letter to send to the UTTC, as well as reviewing the draft memorandum that was prepared. Once the letter is drafted, they will forward a copy to BCWRD.

Mees/Jaszkowiak: Cary reported that we did issue an order to Mr. Jaszkowiak as well as the county had issued an order related to its floodplain ordinance. At our last meeting we had asked our engineer to make an inspection and it was noted that nothing has changed. We are now in a position where we need to take action. One option is to hire a contractor to remove the obstruction. Mr. Jaszkowiak was given the opportunity to come back with an alternative and obviously has not done so.. Noted the work could still be done this year. Cary noted we had a complaint, issued an order and it has not been followed. We had specified a culvert being placed, however at this point we need to just remove the obstruction based on the complaint received and Board action. Cary moved that we retain a contractor to remove the blockage and assess the costs back to the property owner with input from our attorney. Gordon seconded. Discussion was held on giving Mr. Jaszkowiak one more opportunity to remove the blockage by sending him a letter noting when we would have the contractor come out to do the work. One concern with that idea was the weather and the possibility of getting a contractor out to the location. Michael will discuss with Marcus, Burleigh County Engineer to see if he can do this work. There will be one more review of the site prior to sending a letter. Dave will draft the letter. A roll call vote was taken.

Terry Fleck: Yes Motion Carried.

Emery/Koppang: Cary noted that our engineer had made a determination that this was a natural watercourse; however we also requested the State Engineer to make his determination. A letter has been received from the State Engineer determining that this was in fact a watercourse. Cary indicated that an order had been issued and that once we received this letter the corrective should be directed to be completed. Michael noted the question at this time is if Mr. Koppang still willing to allow the placement of the relocated watercourse on his property and felt that we first should contact him. Consensus of the Board was to have Michael contact Mr. Koppang to see if he is still ok with having it on his land, and if so proceed. Cary noted that Jim Lindseth made the inspection and the Emery's wanted to be contacted and Mr. Lindseth did contact them and spoke to the Emery's related to his determination. It was noted the letter was not cc'd to the Emery's and it was recommended that we attach the letter from the State Engineer to the order to the Emery's.



Ron Roehrich: A draft letter is included in the booklet. Cary noted that it is a roadway problem in Burnt Creek Estates and there was no stormwater management plan prepared for this subdivision. A copy of the letter will be sent to Marcus Hall, Neil Modin (Hay Creek Township), and Michael Gunsch noting there is no jurisdiction for this Board to act on this compliant. Bruce pointed out that Chairman Fleck's title on the letter was incorrect. Cary moved that with the change of Chairman Fleck's position the Chairman sign it and send it out. Bruce seconded. Ken questioned the second sentence of the second paragraph regarding natural watercourses or artificial drains. Michael clarified noting that if the water comes off the field in a natural swale and is intercepted by the roadway ditch, it can be considered an artificial drain. If it is just a roadway ditch because of the borrow area to construct the road, not it is likely not considered an artificial drain. Noted not all roadway ditches are considered artificial drains. Dave noted he is comfortable with the letter as written. Motion carried.

Expense Reports:

Burleigh County Commission Chairman Schonert and Commissioner Woodcox, Burleigh County Commissioner, were present to discuss the compensation of the water board members as well as that of other boards. It was felt that there should be discussion on the expectation of board members when they are appointed. Chairman Schonert noted that while the Burleigh County Commission doesn't want to set compensation for boards, they want to review all of the boards. The BCWRD board members currently receive \$135/meeting. It was noted some of the boards get less and some get none at all. Since the BCWRD has their own budget, they set their own compensation and Chairman Schonert felt that there should be an understanding of the board members that you are volunteering for public service. Chairman Schonert indicated that he wasn't sure as to where to draw the line on this related to compensation and requested input on this. Commissioner Woodcox noted that at the last meeting they discussed reviewing all of the boards that they have and the fees each gets. Chairman Schonert noted they do consider this a volunteer position when they appoint and provide compensation however the expectations are not to make us whole for what boards do.

Cary noted that each quarter each of the board members fills out the expense sheet and noted he does not list everything he does related to his duties as part of giving back to the public. The water resource district is a separate political subdivision. The county commission legally gets involved in appointment and approving the budget {mill levee}, and noted most water boards around the state are different. The law sets the limits on what board members can get in compensation, the Board gets to make the per diem rate and we have our own set of statutes we operate under. Cary stated he had spoken to other water management boards around the state and we are comparable to the larger cities such as Cass County, Ward County, etc. Cass County has 4 separate water boards and Morton County has two water boards. Cary noted that some of the water managers get an insurance allowance, some get cell phones, etc. Cary noted we are not elected, we are appointed.



Cary also discussed the transition from Gailen Narum to Terry Fleck as Chairman within a short period of time. Bruce also noted he was appointed in September to fill out a term through the end of the year and discussed the amount of time it would take. Bruce noted the BCWRD does have an expense reimbursement policy but it needs clarification as the workload has changed from just attending the meetings to the amount of time it is taking with the project issues and portfolios. With the 2011 flood event the meetings and the length of time it is taking versus what it used to take has changed dramatically. Discussion was also held on the hourly rates of the professionals that work for the board. Chairman Schonert noted he would like to see this board and the highway department hire an engineer and split the costs. Chairman Schonert felt that our 'house' engineer could split the time 50/50 with the Highway Department. As for legal counsel Bruce feels they should be at full meeting versus just setting up legal issues as things come up during meetings. Bruce also noted that comparing a salary versus a fee that is charged by a consultant is not a fair comparison. Chairman Schonert noted he has asked for our feelings on the matter, but has not heard back from us. Ken noted that we have not ignored it, but have discussed the other costs involved on the engineering side including GIS, surveying, equipment, benefits, etc. noting these fees are billed out separately so it is not generally one engineer we have contracted with, but rather an entire firm that provides the requested services. Consensus was to set up a meeting with Marcus and the BCWRD to discuss the pros and cons of hiring and sharing an engineer to assist the Board.

Chairman Schonert stated that he and Commissioner Woodcox are bringing forth the feeling of the entire County Commission and thanked the board for their service.

Legal Issues:

Jerry Rodgers was present - noted he spoke to Dr. Steve Bernard and has a house moving contractor who wants his I-beam back. Dr. Bernard is afraid that if the I-beam goes the house may fall into the river. Dave Bliss noted that Dave from Carrington Movers called and he also spoke to Michael Gunsch as well. Chairman Fleck noted that this is not a BCWRD Board issue but rather an issue between the homeowner and contractor. Michael noted that the contractor and Dr. Bernard need to work it out as this Board will be purchasing the house and that asset needs to be protected. By removing the beam, if it results in a decrease in the salvage value, it will be an issue, but the residence can be supported by other means prior to removing the beam. Mr. Rodgers noted he will relay this to Dr. Bernard and ask that it gets properly blocked.

Mr. Rodgers also asked if there were any more legal issues holding up the process. Dave noted we were waiting on Mr. Rodger's documentation. Mr. Jerry Rodgers then presented his documentation to David Bliss. Dave noted he will forward this information to FEMA and the SWC for review, once they rule on the duplication of benefits question we can get clearance on the final value of the property. After this happens, it comes back to the BCWRD Board for completion of the purchase.



Dave Bliss noted an issue has been raised by one of the homeowners regarding the removal of septic and drain fields. It is our understanding that it comes under the demolition costs with the board and the state. Dave noted that to clarify, we need a motion or consensus that these items are the Board's responsibility not the homeowners and it will be incorporated into the purchase agreements. Michael noted that when you look at the environmental requirements of reclamation of a residence, since the resident is selling and if there is a significant contaminant that the homeowner had in there basement, it is the sellers responsibility to remove, the simple things are otherwise the buyers. Michael noted as far as the geothermal wells, well systems, septic systems, waterlines and utilities these are all part of the demolition and recovery costs that the Water Resource District participates in and there would be no deducts on the homeowners side.

Consensus of Board that this will be the BCWRD's responsibility as part of the acquisition process to remove geothermal wells, well systems, waterlines, septic, drainage, utilities etc. as part of the demolition recovery costs and will not be the homeowners responsibility and this language can be added to the purchase agreement.

It was noted that we also need to have an informational meeting with the island residents to get them up to speed on what is happening. At this time, Michael noted it appears that this meeting will be in January. Ken asked if we had issued an extension on the buyouts. It was noted there was a formal extension to the 31st of December but it has not been extended beyond that, but all have agreed to sell. Michael noted that there is a discrepancy on Dr. Bernard's buy out with the flood insurance timeline that needs to be determined before the purchase proceeds. Mr. Rodgers asked if we could possibly add a stipulation on Dr. Bernard's in the event FEMA does come back and approve the flood insurance. Dave noted that we need to be careful on this as it is a Federal program and there are legal hurdles that we need to cross before making such a stipulation.

Records Retention Policy: Dave noted this issue is twofold, the first being how long do we have to retain records and what do we need to retain. The state has worked with one district already in this process and we can get this information. The second issue is what does the Board want to keep and what do we need to throw? Dave asked to be a part of his process as there are a lot of legal documents that we have that are helpful in our duties. Dave noted we do have records that we need to keep and also felt we need to decide how the Board stores these records, i.e. electronically, etc. Dave felt we should have someone from IT come in and explain how this process works. Michael noted that he has the majority of the documents of this Board that they have created. Michael also noted they are scanning every booklet from 1999 to present at no cost to the Board. Discussed having a board member do an initial sorting of documents in the back room as in some cases there may be easement or other records that perhaps should not be destroyed.



Comments and Discussion from Public: Wait with the individual issues.

Hogue Island COE Section 33 Bank Stabilization Policy

Bank Stabilization and Specifications Policy: Michael noted he has drafted a preliminary document and has been looking at this and it is an ongoing process.

Turnover agreement & Final Inspection/Warranty Services: Michael has worked with the contractor who completed the bank stabilization restoration. They have completed record drawings and received a letter from COE regarding warranty. The BCWRD is in essence the project sponsor, so the mechanism for reporting issues would be the BCWRD. Michael noted that the agreement is set up that the SWC has taken on at a50/50 cost share in maintenance costs with the SWC but it is ultimately the BCWRD's responsibility. Ken asked about the one year warranty and if it covers all events or specifics. Michael noted he felt it covered only the work that was done. It was noted that a weather or unforeseen flood event would be an extraordinary event and the warrantee would not cover this.

Harbor Drive Flood Control Project:

Public Informational Meeting: Michael updated noting he has had numerous conversations with multiple parties, including Lance Boyer and Andrew Steichen who are representatives for the Riverwood West Homeowners Association. Michael noted that the public meeting held, let them know what the Board could do for them, however they need to petition this Board for a project before you can proceed, as this was the Board's direction to them. We do have petitions from the interior residents mainly who are interested in a project. The project they are looking at is raising Mills Avenue and West Harbor Drive, they are now discussing raising Mills Avenue and only raising a portion of West Harbor Drive and provide access easements to the County. Michael noted his concern in talking to Apex Engineering who is working with the City is that some of these individuals are talking to the City asking them to raise Mills Avenue and the City stated they are. At this time, the BCWRD is not in a position to do anything until they let us know, so we first need to talk to the City to confirm what they are doing. Since West Harbor Drive is a private roadway the residents can do this part of a project on their own. Michael noted he just found this out and will contact the City to see what is happening. Michael noted we have petitions to consider but now we need to go to the City to see what they are doing to determine how to respond to the petition.

Break at 3:30 - reconvened at 3:45 p.m.

Missouri River Flood Hazard Mitigation Studies

Letter requesting funding assistance: This has been resubmitted to John Paszkowski at the SWC.

Missouri River Correctional Center: Still on hold for funding a Public Informational Meeting will eventually be set up after the legislative session to address the assessment of costs to residents.



Sibley Area: SWC funding is under review, and some preliminary alignments have been completed, etc.

Sandy River Drive: Schedule remains to be determined. The Public Informational Meeting is to happen after the first of the year.

Signed copy of Work Order 21: Informational only.

Website project posting: Michael asked about posting the public information meeting summaries on the website. It was the consensus of the Board to allow this. Michael will work with Mona on getting this information posted on the website for the projects currently under development.

Fox Island Project Assessment Report

Alignment #1 and Township Roadway Grade Raise: Michael reviewed and noted by January we will have updated draft engineering costs. Also reviewed Marcus' concern related to the removal of internal drainage issue and noted we do have a culvert to the river with the private levee and gate in place, and would look at a parallel culvert which would only be used during flooding situations.

Updated Draft Engineering Report: Michael noted this will be provided at our January, 2013 meeting.

Sunnyview Flood Control Project: Draft report will be submitted for Board review in January.

Hogue Island Flood Control Project:

Public Informational Meeting: Not scheduled yet, Jerry Rodgers has volunteered his shop for the meeting.

Burnt Creek Flood Control Repair Project:

Plan Set: Michael noted the 50% plan set is complete. Michael spoke to Dennis Reep and the construction dollars for the 75/25% cost share are still not available, but there is an agreement in effect for engineering costs, the project cost is now on hold.

Hay Creek Sediment & Geomorphic Assessment Update: It was noted that Mike Ell, ND Health Department signed the agreement and has returned it to the Board.



Apple Valley Cooperative Lagoon Project:

Documents: Michael provided the documents to the Health Department and we are still waiting on them. Bond council recommended completing a draw on the loan account. Michael noted the Board could draw on it past engineering costs incurred but can't draw on it for upcoming costs. It was the consensus of the Board to do a draw on the account for engineering costs. Ken asked response time from the ND Health Department on the contract award – Michael felt we should know sometime in January.

Other Old Business:

Rural Ring Dike Cost Share: Michael noted they looked at it for Burleigh County noting it is available but it has to come through the BCWRD not the general public. Noted the program is available however the Board would need to sponsor it. Michael felt at this time it is premature to sponsor such a program until you have an idea of where our levees are going. Terry recommended that we table it at this time and look at it further down the road. Gordon asked about the constituent who asked about it, Michael noted with the Boards consensus he can talk to him and send him the information. Noted in his case he could do it, but all costs would be borne by the landowner and he would need to hire his own engineer and contractor.

SWMP Reviews: Ongoing, Michael is still visiting with Marcus on this.

Work Orders Past and Active: Gordon, Ken and Michael are working on this, due to time constraints, discussed possibly doing a conference call.

New Business:

Board Portfolio Appointments: Tabled until January

Missouri River Snagging and Clearing: Michael discussed the debris removal around the University of Mary area. It was noted that if the district or joint district sponsors the project could move forward. The COE had issues on this a few years ago, however now that it is in the channels we are able to pursue for permitting. The SWC cost share funding is 50/50, though there is no known cost at this time. Currently there are trees blocking the main channel. Noted we may not be able to dredge, but we will be able to at least try to remove the trees. Cary felt that we should still pursue dredging which would be operated by the State Engineer. Ken moved to authorize our engineer to start formal discussions with the State about the 50% cost share, and to authorize discussions with the Corp regarding the permitting process to do a study and get going on this. Cary seconded. It was noted the last time we did try to authorize this, the County felt we should not have to use County but COE money. Discussed the need to get the State Engineer going on this and since it is state land, there should be more monies on cost share. It was noted that we also need to include the Lower Heart and Morton County WRD in the discussion. A roll call vote was taken:

Michael noted with our consensus he would also like to talk to Bill Robinson with the Lower Heart WRD as he has already spoken to Wade Bachmeier from Morton County WRD.

2013 Meeting Schedule: Discussed the next meeting which is January 8th – consensus to change it to the 9th as some board members were unable to attend.

Website Annual Hosting: under bills, it has been approved.

Correspondence or Document information: Reviewed.

Miscellaneous: Chairman Fleck thanked Bruce McCollum for his service on the BCWRD board.

PROPOSAL FOR SERVICES Amended: 8/10/09

This contract for services is entered into by the Burleigh County Water Resource District (BCWRD), and Personalized Management Services, Inc. (PMS), pursuant to which PMS, as an independent contractor, will provide the administrative and management services to BCWRD for a fee of \$20.00 per hour from February 12, 2007 until 60 (sixty) day written notice of termination is given by either party.

Terms

The term of this contract shall commence on February 12, 2007 and will be reviewed in three months.

Prior Contracts

The term of this contract shall commence on February 12, 2007. Any and all prior contracts for secretarial services for BCWRD are no longer valid.

PMS or any of its staff cannot be held responsible for any business and/or organization decisions made on behalf of BCWRD.

Miscellaneous

This Agreement and the attached Scope of Services represent the entire understanding of BCWRD and PMS and supersede any prior or contemporaneous agreements or representations. This Agreement may be amended only by further written agreement signed by the authorized representatives of the BCWRD and PMS.

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the State of North Dakota. Any legal proceeding brought to enforce the terms of this Agreement or to seek a remedy for breach of this Agreement shall be brought in State or federal court in the State of North Dakota.

Confidentiality

PMS agrees that with respect to any and all materials, reports, correspondence, or other documents which have been stamped or otherwise identified as confidential matters by the BCWRD'S Executive Committee ("the Confidential Materials"), PMS shall not disclose, distribute or publish such Confidential Materials to any third party, unless otherwise requested by a duly authorized member of the BCWRD.

Other Costs

Postage, telephone, printing, copying, fax copies, supplies, travel (at state rates), bulk mailing costs, and other incidental costs for items that are for exclusive use by BCWRD will be in addition to the contract fee and will be paid directly by the provider from BCWRD funds.

Evaluation

The BCWRD may evaluate the management and administrative services provided by PMS.

Termination

This contract/arrangement can be terminated by either party upon a sixty (60) day written notice of the intent to terminate to the other party.

Information & Property

All computer data and paper records prepared by PMS specifically for the BCWRD or prepared or provided by BCWRD, its officers, directors, members, or agents, along with supplies pur-

chased by BCWRD are the property of BCWRD. Other data and records, including and regarding the operations of PMS, along with all other supplies and property, shall remain the property of PMS.

Upon termination of this contract, all BCWRD property will be returned to the BCWRD and all outstanding PMS bills will be paid by BCWRD.

Computer data will be placed on disks compatible with an IBM format in an ASCII file - data fields will be documented on paper - a hard copy will be provided of all data.

PMS may retain a copy of BCWRD'S data and records for archival purposes. Any additional expenses incurred during the transfer process from PMS will be billed according to the contract.

Indemnification

The BCWRD shall indemnify and hold harmless PMS, its officers, directors, employees, and agents for and against all liabilities related to any and all claims and causes of action by third parties, including but not limited to judgments, verdicts, settlements, and fines resulting from any act or omission of the BCWRD, its officers, directors, members or agents.

In your letter of September 21, 2012 the District requested the State Engineer to determine if a watercourse exists at 7245 Russel Road, a location in the SE¼NW¼, Section 8, T139N-R79W, Gibbs Township.

I have reviewed several aerial photos of the area, one dating from 1957 before there was much development of the area, up to 2010. Also I reviewed the quad map of the area and 2009 LiDAR maps of this area. In some of these photos and maps the lot in question was super imposed for reference. On November 6, 2012 I conducted an on-site investigation of the area in question. During the on-site visit multiple photographs were taken of the area for future reference.

After reviewing all the aerial photos, on the ground photographs, other pertinent information, and conducting the on-site visit, it is apparent that this lot is the major outlet for drainage from this development. Therefore, it is my opinion that a watercourse is located across the back yard of 7245 Russel Road starting further upstream and continues southeasterly to the southeast corner of the lot and into the surrounding agricultural land.

Complaint of Obstruction of Natural Watercourse
Lot 7B, Block 2, T-J Ranch Estates, Gibbs Township, Burleigh County

Dear Mr. Emery:

The Burleigh County Water Resource District (BCWRD) has investigated a complaint filed against you regarding an obstruction of a natural watercourse filed by Mr. Chris Koppang. Based on our site inspection and review of aerial topography, it was determined that your residence was constructed directly within a natural watercourse as defined in ND Century Code Section 61-01-06. The Office of the ND State Engineer has subsequently confirmed the determination that a natural watercourse exists and has been obstructed.

North Dakota Century Code Section 61-16.1-51 states that, if a water resource district determines that a watercourse has been obstructed, the board shall notify the landowner by registered mail as to the nature of the obstruction and order its removal. In this instance your home actually constitutes the obstruction, and removal of the home would seem to constitute an impractical solution at this point. Therefore, we are willing, in this instance, to allow a relocation of the watercourse rather than removal of the home.

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to remedy the obstruction of the watercourse in question by constructing an alternate drainage route as illustrated in the enclosed drawing. This remedy must be completed by May 1, 2013. You shall notify the Burleigh County Water Resource District upon completion, so that the construction can be inspected for compliance.

If you fail to comply with this order and fail to construct the alternate drainage and notify this office of its completion by May 1, 2013, the Burleigh County Water Resource District shall procure the services necessary to construct the remedy and assess the cost against your property, including all costs incurred by the BCWRD in investigating and resolving this complaint.

In accordance with NDCC 61-16.1-51, you may demand in writing a hearing on this matter. Upon receipt of the demand, the board shall set a hearing date within fifteen days from the date the demand is received. A landowner aggrieved by action of the board under this section may appeal the decision of the board to the district court of the county in which the land is located in accordance with the procedure provided in NDCC Section 28-34-01.

The Burleigh County Water Resource District is working with Houston Engineering to prepare a Preliminary Engineering Analysis for the Fox Island Flood Control Project. This process was initiated in 2009 in response to a petition received from landowners who owned lots predominantly in the interior of Fox Island, south of Mills Avenue. At the time the petitioners were seeking a project to provide flood protection from an event similar to the 2009 ice jam. In response to the 2011 flood, the scope of our investigation was expanded, at the landowner's request, to identify alternatives that would protect all properties on Fox Island south of Mills Avenue for a flood equivalent to that experienced in 2011.

During this process, Burleigh County developed a conceptual master plan for flood protection, consisting of roadway grade raises and levees that included all of Fox Island. About this same time the Riverwood West Homeowners Association contacted us and inquired if the scope of work for Fox Island Flood Control Project could be expanded to include the area north of Mills Avenue in the Harbor Drive area. Houston Engineering subsequently was directed to develop a draft preliminary engineering analysis for this area, and the public meeting held on July 30th to present the draft findings and provide the public an opportunity to provide input.

One alternative evaluated for the Harbor Drive area involved construction of an earthen levee along the river. Feedback during the public meeting included significant opposition to this alternative from landowners whose property was directly adjacent to the Missouri River. A petition was presented at the meeting from these residents voicing specific opposition and rejecting any option to obtain easements on which to construct a levee system. Southport residents also voiced opposition to any project that would assess them as they perceived themselves as receiving little or no benefit.

It is our understanding the interior residents, those between Harbor Drive, West Harbor Drive and Mills Avenue support a project, was documented in a petition provided to the BCWRD. While one alternative involved constructing a levee along the river, another involved raising West Harbor Drive to provide flood control benefits to the interior residences. This would leave residences along the river outside the protected area. While they would be provided improved access, in the future they would not be protected by the construction of any publicly funded temporary flood protection measures.

It is also our understanding both Harbor Drive and West Harbor Drive, which are privately owned roadways, are in need of repair and resurfacing. This would be an opportune time to combine these repairs with a grade raise that would provide flood protection for the interior properties and improve access for all residents. This alternative provides the protection desired by the interior residents, without the levee opposed by the residents on the river. It also allows the grade raise costs, which provide flood

protection benefits to the interior residents and access benefits to all residents, to be cost shared as a flood control project through the North Dakota State Water Commission. This cost share is only available for construction costs associated with the grade raise and not the roadway resurfacing. The entire project could still be constructed via an assessment project district, which would also allow the costs to be assessed over a period of years rather than a lump sum payment, which we understand can be required if the roadway were repaired under Homeowners Association authority. Because the Southport Residents share the operation and maintenance responsibility for Harbor Drive, they would cost share in the resurfacing costs for that roadway.

It is also necessary to raise and re-surface a portion of Mills Avenue to provide flood containment. As a City street, the City of Bismarck would be requested to fund the re-surfacing costs, while the interior residents would be responsible for the grade raise based on the flood control benefit provided. The following table summarizes a conceptual breakdown of cost responsibilities for what appears to be a viable alternative.

Because the roadway re-surfacing is required due to grade raises it could be included in the flood control project costs with the entire cost being assessed to the benefited residents. As noted above, this allows the re-surfacing to be re-paid over a period of years through the special assessment district. The level of assessment or cost distribution to the various lots would be apportioned in accordance with the conceptual breakdown provided in the table above. Resurfacing costs shown to be the responsibility of the Riverwood West Homeowner's Association would actually be shared equally by the association residents, while the grade raise costs would only be assessed to the interior properties receiving a flood control benefit. The Southport residents would be assessed their (50%) share of the costs associated with the re-surfacing of Harbor Drive in accordance with what we understand to be the current agreement.

Several other issues are necessary to further clarify this project. As the result would be permanent grade raises of private roadways we propose that all operation and maintenance for these roadways remain with the Riverwood West Homeowners and Southport properties in accordance with your existing agreements. The only obligation for the BCWRD is to complete the project assessment and payments

until the bonds are repaid. There will also need to be an easement provided to Burleigh County to allow the future placement of temporary flood control measures on these roadways. This document would be developed only if the project moves forward and may require the roadways be constructed to a higher standard that would better survive the heavier truck loading, and possibly some additional width, where practical.

If this appears to be a viable project we would entertain the option of holding another public informational meeting for the Harbor Drive and Southport residents to receive additional input regarding this conceptual approach. Based on this input we would then entertain a petition from the residents requesting us to proceed with additional preliminary engineering work, followed by a request to the State Water Commission for a conditional cost share, then a formal public hearing and vote to construct the project.

We, the undersigned, hereby request the Burleigh County Water Resource District to initiate a project in accordance with North Dakota Century Code Chapter 61-16.1 to construct permanent flood control measures to protect residential structures north of Mills Avenue.

We understand that the cost of any such improvements will need to be approved by a vote of the benefitted landowners and assessed accordingly. By our signature we recognize that a flood control project will benefit our properties and agree to be assessed for a portion of the cost to implement these flood protection measures, should the project be approved by a majority vote of those located within the assessment district.

It is further requested that the Burleigh County Water Resource District evaluate two alternatives, including projected costs and assessment distribution. After which a Public Informational Meeting would be held so the benefited residents can weigh in on a preferred alternative before it is presented at a Public Hearing and voted on. The first alternative would be as generally outlined in the Burleigh County Water Resource District's letter of August 22, 2012. The second alternative would provide lesser protection utilizing a grade raise on Mills Avenue and West Harbor Drive, with easements obtained on the adjoining streets to allow for the placement of temporary flood protection measures during large flood events.

Terry, et. al.:

I located the City of Bismarck temporary flood levee protection map.

The recent funding was received for removal of Levee A, D, E and F, as highlighted on the map.

These levees are all located behind the new Tavis Roadway Flood Control Gate, with the exception of Levee A.

These levees were left in place after the flood event, to be used should another flood occur in 2012.

With the Tavis structure in place Levee D, E and F become somewhat redundant, though not without some purpose if left in place. It is anticipated that the issue came down to the fact that if removed the City would get reimbursed for the cost to construct and then remove them. If left in place the City's construction costs are not reimbursable. The total cost recovered based on the grant is \$1.3 Million.

I will have Mona place this email and map in the January briefing book for Board information. Am sending this to the Board as viewing the map in a large scale should provide a better view.

Syd Stewart, Bismarck, North Dakota has filed an application with the State Engineer to deepen a portion of a side channel of the Missouri River in Burleigh County.

The 2011 Missouri River flood made significant changes to the river system through Burleigh County including the size and shape of an island at the southern end of Hogue Island. At a river stage that approximates the ordinary high water mark, Missouri River water flows through this side channel and separates the island from the left bank of the Missouri River. During periods of lower flows, the side channel is cut off from the main channel of the Missouri River at the upper and lower ends of the island leaving a long narrow stagnant pool in between. The applicant is proposing to deepen a portion of the side channel at the lower end of the island to allow the river to once again flow into the side channel. The constructed channel would allow for freshening of the existing pool and watercraft access to the main channel of the Missouri River.

Specifically, the project would involve dredging approximately 2,000 cubic yards of material to form a 6-foot deep channel approximately 30 feet wide and 300 feet in length. Dredged material would be placed and spread on the island immediately north of the constructed channel.

Construction will occur in the SW ¼ NW ¼ of Section 3, Township 139 North, Range 81 West, Burleigh County.

Projects which lie either partially or wholly below the ordinary high watermark of navigable streams or waters may require authorization from the State Engineer prior to construction or operation. At the discretion of the State Engineer, a public meeting may be held on the project for the purpose of gathering information. The State Engineer will consider riparian owner's rights, recreation, navigation, aesthetics, erosion, wildlife, water quality, maintenance of existing water flows, alternative uses, and the environment in determining whether to grant the authorization.

To ensure that all environmental, economic and social factors are considered in the evaluation of this application, your views and comments are solicited. It is requested that any comments or

information be forwarded within 30 days of the date of this mailing to the State Engineer, at 900 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck ND. If no reply is received within the 30 days, it will be assumed that your agency has no comment on this project.
