Abstract/Executive Summary*:

The Burleigh County Water Resource District (BCWRD) intends to construct a supplemental water supply for the McDowell Dam Reservoir to prevent the pot ential degradation of the natural habitat and loss of a valuable recreational resource during periods of continued drought. This degradation will adversely impa ct the swimming, canoeing, kayaking, pedal boat and recreational concession activities. This is a major recreational facility and use is dramatically increasin g.

This project accomplishes the key objectives by providing a supplemental water supply by diverting appropriated waters from Apple Creek to the McDowell Da m reservoir. The McDowell Dam watershed is inadequate to maintain full service levels during extended droughts. Water quality also suffers during normal a nd low water levels, which negatively impacts the shoreline habitat, fishery and overall public recreational value of the facility. By supplementing the water su pply, service levels can be maintained and water quality maintained or improved. Water imported from Apple Creek will be treated prior to discharge into the r eservoir to reduce the nitrogen and phosphorous loading.

The BCWRD has not finalized the routing of the intake line and two alternatives are under consideration. Factors that will determine the final route include co st, ease of construction, ease of access for operation and maintenance, and landowner willingness to grant an easement.

The Burleigh County Water Resource District (BCWRD) has a five-member Board of Commissioners, including a Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary/Treasu rer and two Managers.

The general authorities of the BCWRD are described in ND Century Code Section 61-16.1-09. In addition to these broadly defined general authorities, the BC WRD has other specific and statutorily defined regulatory authorities.

The BCWRD was the original local sponsor for the construction of McDowell Dam by the Soil Conservation Service (now NRCS). In accordance with the 197 5 project agreement, the BCWRD is the owner of the project and since its creation has acquired additional properties to expand this recreation area. The BC WRD is responsible for operation and maintenance throughout the projected 50 year project life, as well as after the agreement expires.

Purpose of Grant*:

The project's goal is to provide a supplemental water supply by diverting available waters from Apple Creek in the spring into the McDowell Dam reservoir. Th e ND State Engineer has allocated 300 acre-feet annually for such use. The recreation area saw over 58,000 vehicles entering the site in 2020 and attendance e is on pace to exceed that number in 2021. Water quality suffers during low reservoir levels, which negatively impacts the facility's public recreational value. By supplementing the reservoir's water supply from Apple Creek, full services levels can be maintained, and water quality will improve. The grant funding will help to preserve and protect the water levels and water quality enjoyed by community residents.

Attachment A contains figures depicting a preliminary design layout. The BCWRD has not finalized the routing of the intake line, and two alternatives are still being considered. Factors that will determine the final route include cost, ease of construction, ease of access for operation and maintenance, and landowne r willingness to grant an easement. All disturbed areas will be fully restored to preconstruction status. Additionally, trees will be placed near the project struc tures to enhance the aesthetic and provide a visual barrier for the pump station and treatment structure. Exact tree and shrub placements have not yet been determined; however, a planting plan will need to be developed as part of final facility design and easements.

The project will take an innovative approach by employing a water treatment facility to remove nitrogen and phosphorous from the waters being delivered from Apple Creek to and prevent additional detrimental nutrient loading in the reservoir.

If selected this project will likely be designed and constructed in 2022 with the possibility of construction extending into 2023.

HEI has provided guidance to the BCWRD on these facilities including the completion of a TMDL Study (2004), a strategic plan (2005), an al um treatment (2006) a supplemental water supply study (2009), and various facility maintenance and improvements. The BCWRD has an onsite Park Manag er as well as a contract with the Bismarck Parks and Recreation District to manage this facility. It has taken time for the BCWRD to accumulate the necess ary funds, during which it has been fortunate that no extended drought has occurred.

NOTICE AND ORDER FOR OBSTRUCTION REMOVAL

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Dosch:

A drainage complaint was filed with the Burleigh County Water Resource District (District) regarding an obstruction on the artificial watercourse (a platted and constructed stormwater easement) located on your property, see attached. It is our understanding you planted these trees within the stormwater easement on both Lot 9 and Lot 10.

The District has conducted a site review to evaluate the existence, nature, and extent of the obstruction. The findings based on our investigation are outlined in the enclosed documentation. The District has determined that an obstruction does exist and must be removed. Subsequently, the District hereby orders removal of any tree placed within the stormwater easement limits, which is 20 feet west into Lot 9 and 15 feet east into Lot 10, which is along a shared property line.

North Dakota law requires that a water resource board, having noted the existence of an obstruction, shall notify the landowner by registered mail and require the removal of the obstruction. Therefore, this letter shall serve as the *Notice and Order of the Burleigh County Water Resource District* to you to remove the noted obstruction within a reasonable time but not less than fifteen days from the date of service of this letter upon you. If the obstruction is not removed within this fifteen day period, the District shall complete the work and assess the costs for this work to your property.

You have the right to request a formal hearing before the District on this matter in accordance with N.D.C.C. 61-32-07. If you wish to have a formal hearing, you must demand a hearing in writing to the District within fifteen (15) days from the date of this letter. If you request a hearing, you must attend the hearing and be prepared to make whatever statements and present whatever witnesses, documents, or other evidence you wish the District to consider in this matter. In the alternative, any aggrieved party may appeal the District's decision to the Burleigh County District Court in accordance with N.D.C.C. 61-16.1-54 and 28-34-01, respectively. Finally, any aggrieved party has a right to appeal the District's decision to the North Dakota State Engineer in accordance with N.D.C.C. 61-32-08.



6201 Tiffany Drive Drainage Complaint Review Memorandum Trees planted in the platted stormwater easement




Findings:

Site review was conducted by Manager Cory Palm. This photo clearly indicates the three rows of trees that were planted within the stormwater easement, with some located on the adjoining property to the west, 6109 Tiffany Drive. As an artificial watercourse, (constructed conveyance) and a platted stormwater easement this location is under the BCWRD's jurisdiction. Obstructions to flows within this easement, in this instance the trees, present a risk for excessive snow accumulation, as well as erosion within and along the easement. Such obstructions are not allowed and should be removed. Therefore, it is recommended the BCWRD order the removal of these trees from within the stormwater easement including those on the neighboring properties. The property owner should be provided notice to remove within specified timeline, after which verification should be completed.

DAM, DIKE, OR OTHER DEVICE COMPLAINTS (N.D.C.C. § 61-16.1-53):

The District will determine if a landowner or tenant constructed a dam, dike, or other device without first securing a construction permit as required under N.D.C.C. § 61-16.1-38, or in conflict with the terms or conditions of a construction permit. North Dakota Administrative Code § 89-08-01-01 defines "other device" as "a water control structure, other than a dam or dike, including diversions and holding ponds, lagoons, or dugouts."

DRAINAGE COMPLAINTS (N.D.C.C. § 61-32-07):

Surface Drainage: The District will determine if a landowner or tenant constructed any surface drainage that impacts a watershed area of 80 acres or more without first securing a drainage permit as required under N.D.C.C. § 61-32-03, or in conflict with the terms or conditions of a drainage permit.

Tile Drainage: The District will determine if a landowner or tenant constructed or installed a tile or subsurface drainage system with a footprint of 80 acres or more without first securing a tile or subsurface permit as required under N.D.C.C. § 61-32-03.1, or in conflict with the terms or conditions of a tile or subsurface permit.

OBSTRUCTION TO DRAIN COMPLAINTS (N.D.C.C. § 61-16.1-51):


The District will determine if a landowner or tenant has intentionally or negligently caused an obstruction to a natural watercourse or drain.

The District must act pursuant to the appropriate code listed above. The District shall investigate and make a determination within a reasonable amount of time (not to exceed 120 days for dams, dikes, other devices, or drains). The District shall notify all parties of its decision as required by code. If complained of activity was a dam, dike, other device, or drain, the District's decision may be appealed to the State Engineer within 30 days of the District's decision. If the complained of activity was an obstruction to drain, the District's decision may be appealed to District Court.

Subsurface Drainage Permit Process Burleigh County WRD

Background:

The process described below is based on the requirements of N.D. Century Code regarding subsurface drainage permits. House Bill 1437 was passed in the 67th North Dakota Legislature which amended Section 61-32-03.1 of the N.D. Century Code and adds Section 61-32-03.2 (expires December 31, 2022). The process prescribed in the amended section requires quick response times to permit applications by North Dakota Water Resource Districts and creates a notification requirement and database establishment for smaller (<80 acres) subsurface drainage systems.

Process:

Subsurface drainage permit *applications* must be submitted on SFN 61244 (5/2021) which can be downloaded electronically from the North Dakota State Water Commission web site (http://www.swc.state.nd.us/reg_approp/drainagepermits/) Incomplete or inaccurate submissions will be returned to the applicant immediately.

Subsurface drainage permit *notifications* must be submitted on SFN 61990 (5/2021) which can be downloaded electronically from the North Dakota State Water Commission web site (http://www.swc.state.nd.us/reg_approp/drainagepermits/) Incomplete or inaccurate submissions will be returned to the applicant immediately.

Permit Applications (SFN 61244 (5/2021)):

The Burleigh Water Resource District (WRD) process will be as follows for permit applications on SFN 61244 (5/2021):

1. Applications (SFN 61244 (5/2021)) received in hardcopy format, accompanied by the appropriate Tile Drainage Permit Fee (currently \$500 per application), by the Burleigh County WRD Secretary will *immediately* be date stamped, scanned, and emailed to the Burleigh County WRD Chairman - currently Dennis Reep (dwrburleighwrd@gmail.com or Cory Palm, Manager (cpalmbcwrd@gmail.com) and to the Burleigh County WRD Engineer – currently Michael Gunsch (mgunsch@houstoneng.com). The Tile Drainage Permit Fee in the form of check or money order received by the Burleigh County WRD Secretary, along with the original hardcopy of the Subsurface Drainage Permit Application itself will be maintained in a file at the BCWRD Office Bismarck, North Dakota). If the application is not signed, is not accompanied by the application fee or is otherwise obviously incomplete, the applicant shall immediately be notified in writing (email is acceptable), but also by phone where practical, that the application is incomplete, and no further review will occur until a completed application and fee are received. All applications shall be assigned a sequential permit number unique to Burleigh County in the format of "SSP-YY-###".

- 2. Applications (SFN 61244 (5/2021)) received electronically by the Burleigh County WRD Secretary (Wendy Egle <u>bcwrd@midco.net</u>) will be *immediately* forwarded to the same two individuals described in Step 1 above. If the Burleigh County WRD does not receive the application fee within 1 business day of the WRD's receipt of the electronic application, the applicant shall immediately be notified in writing (email is acceptable), but also by telephone where practical, that the application is incomplete, and no further review will occur until the application fee is received.
- 3. Within three (3) business days of receipt of application by the Burleigh County WRD Secretary, a determination of the completeness of the application (as prescribed in NDCC Section 61-32-03.1.3) will be made by the Burleigh County WRD Engineer and communicated to the Burleigh County WRD Board members, secretary, and the Water Resource Board Attorney. A completed application includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. A completed application form signed by an applicant and filed with the district;
 - b. Evidence of ownership for each parcel to be tiled according to the tax rolls of the county in which the parcel is located;
 - c. A project design, including:
 - i. A detailed drawing depicting the subsurface water management system's location overlain on an aerial photograph of the parcel;
 - ii. The system's location by legal description identifying either the relevant quarter, section, township, and range or the relevant block and lot number;
 - iii. The physical footprint of the system's layout;
 - iv. The tile-main sizes and locations;
 - v. The laterals to the tile-main sizes and locations;
 - vi. Surface inlet sizes and locations; and
 - vii. Outlet sizes, locations, and types;
 - d. A downstream flow map or depiction of the flow direction from each outlet location for one mile [1.61 kilometers] downstream which includes the location of the downstream parcels by legal description identifying either the relevant quarter, section, township, and range or the relevant block and lot number; and
 - e. Evidence of ownership for each parcel within one mile [1.61 kilometers] downstream of each project outlet according to the tax rolls for the county in which the parcel is located, unless the distance to the nearest assessment drain, natural watercourse, slough, or lake is less than one mile [1.61 kilometers] downstream of a proposed outlet, in which case the applicant shall provide evidence of ownership for each parcel between the outlet and the nearest assessment drain, natural watercourse, slough, or lake.

If the Application is determined to be incomplete, the applicant will be notified in writing by the Burleigh County WRD Engineer, including a list of information required to complete the application. Submission of additional information by the Applicant will start a new review period of 3 business days. In the event the application is withdrawn, the application fee will not be refunded.

4. Upon receipt of an application determined to be complete, the Burleigh County WRD Engineer will prepare and email any recommended conditions to the Burleigh County WRD Board.

- 5. Conditions are limited as prescribed in NDCC Section 61-32-03.1.4. Regardless of whether there are any recommended conditions, the Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall notify the Burleigh County WRD Board, secretary, and legal counsel of the need to schedule a special meeting to consider the permit application to meet the 30-day review period set by NDCC Section 61-32-03.1.5. If the next regularly scheduled Burleigh County WRD meeting falls within the 30-day review period, no special meeting will be held.
- 6. If an application is determined to be complete, the Burleigh County WRD Chairman shall certify its completeness by filling out and signing the last section on page 3 of SFN 61244 (5/2021).
- 7. After consideration and approval of the permit application, the Burleigh County WRD Secretary shall notify all landowners as listed on the permit application via certified mail as prescribed in NDCC Section 61-32-03.1.6. The notification shall include the downstream flow map of the system. The permit application material shall not be included in the notification.
- 8. The Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall determine whether the subsurface system will discharge into the watershed area of an assessment drain. If deemed to do so, the Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall inform the Burleigh County WRD Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting for their consideration of including this land in the assessment district, if not already so.
- After consideration and approval of the permit application, the Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall complete SFN 61243 (5/2021) and present to the Burleigh County WRD Chairman for signature. Upon signature, the Burleigh County WRD Secretary shall send the completed form to the Office of the State Engineer at 900 East Boulevard Ave, Bismarck, ND 58505.
- 10. The Burleigh County WRD Secretary shall retain the application in the Burleigh County WRD filing system for reference and documentation. However, detailed drawings submitted with the application for a permit are exempt records under NDCC Section 44-04-18 and may be provided to individuals only as necessary for the consideration of a permit approval.

Notifications (SFN 61990 (5/2021)) (Note, this law expires December 31, 2022):

The Burleigh Water Resource District (WRD) process will be as follows for subsurface systems notifications (less than 80 acres) on SFN 61990 (5/2021):

1. Notifications (SFN 61990 (5/2021)) received in hardcopy format by the Burleigh County WRD Secretary will be date stamped, scanned, and emailed to the WRD Chairman - currently Dennis Reep (dwrburleighwrd@gmail.com) or Cory Palm, Manager (cpalmbcwrd@gmail.com) and to the Burleigh County WRD Engineer – currently Michael Gunsch (mgunsch@houstoneng.com). The original hardcopy of the Subsurface Drainage Permit Notification itself will be maintained in a file at Burleigh County Water Resource District Office (Bismarck, North Dakota). All notifications shall be assigned a sequential notification number unique to Burleigh County in the format of "SSN-YY-###".

- 2. Notifications (SFN 61990 (5/2021)) received electronically by the WRD Secretary (bcwrd@midco.net) will be forwarded to the same two individuals described in Step 1 above.
- 3. The Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall review the notification to determine whether the information required by statute has been provided. If the notification is determined to be incomplete or erroneous, the Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall contact the subsurface system owner to obtain corrected and complete information. The required information includes, but is not limited to the following:
 - a. The system's total acreage and legal description of the land being drained;
 - b. The outlet locations and types; and
 - c. The flow direction from each outlet location.
- 4. If it is determined the subsurface system does not comply with NDCC Section 61-32-03.2.2, the Burleigh County WRD Engineer will inform the Burleigh County WRD Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting for consideration of notice to the subsurface system owner of the non-compliance and order the information to comply with NDCC Section 61-32-03.2.2 (NDCC Section 61-32-03.2.4).
- 5. The Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall determine whether the subsurface system will discharge into the watershed area of an assessment drain. If deemed to do so, the Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall inform the Burleigh County WRD Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting for their consideration of including this land in the assessment district, if not already so.
- 6. The Burleigh County WRD Engineer shall populate a database of the information provided on SFN 61990 for the Burleigh County WRD's records. The database will be maintained with the Burleigh County WRD Secretary.
- 7. Information submitted with the notification are exempt records under NDCC Section 44-04-18.

Public Notice: Stakeholder Notification – Important September 1, 2021

The US Army Corps of Engineers intends to begin reductions in releases from Garrison Dam. During the weekend of September 11th there is a planned reduction from a daily average release of 21,000 cfs down to 18,000 cfs. Releases will then be further reduced later that week to a daily average of 16,000 cfs followed by further reductions bringing flows to a daily average release of approximately 13,000 cfs.

These measures are being taken due to continued widespread drought conditions in the upper Midwest. It is important that stakeholders using the Missouri River in the Bismarck-Mandan area be aware of these releases. It is likely boat ramps and river access could become unusable and access difficult. Those with boats or recreational vehicles or docks in the river should monitor conditions and remove them prior to flow reductions and restricted access. There will be no consideration for flow changes should any vehicles or equipment become stranded.
