# **Terms and Conditions for Sale of Auctioned Properties**

# 1. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Burleigh County Water Resource District ("Seller") will receive sealed bids for property it has acquired through voluntary acquisition. Bids shall be delivered either by mail or in person to: Bliss & Stebbins, LLC, 400 East Broadway Avenue, Suite 308, Bismarck, North Dakota 58502-4126 (701-223-5769) until 5 pm (CDT) the day before the bid, or they may be delivered in person at the time and place noted for the bid opening.

The sealed bids will be opened during a special meeting of the Burleigh County Water Resource District on March 10, 2015 at 10 am, held in the Tom Baker Meeting Room, City/County Building 221 North 5th Street, Bismarck, ND 58501. The top five Buyers will have an opportunity to increase their bids at that time.

Buyers will not be discriminated against based on sex, race, color, religion, or national origin.

# 2. PROPERTY RESTRICTIONS

Deed restrictions will not allow the construction of <u>any structures</u> on any of the four properties at any time. The Burleigh County Water Resource District also retains the right to construct a future flood control project across the properties. The properties are also subject to existing easements for maintenance of federally constructed bank stabilization measures. Local covenants may further restrict the use of the property. Copies of these deed restrictions and easements are attached to these Terms and Conditions as Appendix A.

# 3. DISCREPANCIES

Information presented on the Seller's website and printed and digital ads are for informational purposes only. Discrepancies, if any, are the Buyer's sole responsibility. The Buyer agrees to hold the Seller harmless for any damages as a result of discrepancies not resolved at the time of bidding.

# 4. **AUCTION DETAILS**

Auction details will be posted on the Burleigh County Water Resource District's website located at <a href="www.bcwrd.org">www.bcwrd.org</a>. Specific questions as to the sale may be directed to District Engineer Michael Gunsch (323-0200) or David Bliss, Bliss & Stebbins, LLC (223-5769).



# 5. SUBMITTING A BID

All bids shall be binding. The Buyer will be required to sign a bill of sale and must comply with the terms and conditions stated herein and those terms and conditions set forth in the bill of sale. Retractions of bids will not be allowed.

# 6. <u>INSURANCE AND RISK OF LOSS</u>

The Buyer is responsible for obtaining insurance on the property within 7 days of the date of the sale. Risk of loss or damage to the property will transfer from the Seller to the Buyer upon acceptance of the Buyer's bid. The Seller shall not be held responsible for any losses incurred by the Buyer once the auction is complete and the sale is finalized.

If flooding conditions occur and warrant emergency flood protection to be placed on the existing lot, the Seller reserves the right to construct emergency flood protection operations on the existing lot at any future date.

# 7. AMENDMENTS, MODIFICATIONS OR WAIVERS

No amendment, modification, or waiver of any condition, provision or term shall be valid or of any effect unless made in writing and signed by Buyer and Seller, or a duly authorized representative, and specifying with particularity the extent and nature of such amendment, modification or waiver. Any waiver by any party of any default of another party shall not effect or impair any right arising from any subsequent default. Except as expressly and specifically stated otherwise, nothing herein shall limit the remedies and rights of the parties.

# 8. INDEMNITY AND HOLD HARMLESS

The Buyer agrees to indemnify and hold the Seller, its directors, employees, attorneys and agents harmless from any and all claims, liabilities, losses, damages and expenses, including claims arising from death or personal injury and attorney's fees, that may arise directly or indirectly from the condition of the property or the Buyer's performance of these terms and conditions.

PROJECT NAME: Apple Creek Industrial Park Levee Assessment

PROBLEM: The existing Apple Creek Industrial Park Levee has been

de-accredited by FEMA resulting in a significant hindrance

to development within this subdivision.

**RECOMMENDED ACTIONS:** Complete an assessment of the current condition of the

levee and identify actions required to certify the levee

under the NFIP.

IDENTIFY THE LEAD AGENCY: Burleigh County Water Resource District

**COSTS:** \$150,000

FUNDING SOURCE: State Water Commission & Local Assessments

**TIMEFRAME:** WRD is waiting for landowners to provide petition and a

bond for completing this assessment. Anticipated

PROGRESS: A scope of work and budget have been prepared. Local

landowners have met to discuss the need to provide a bond for the local share of this assessment. The North Dakota State Water Commission has provided a cost share agreement to the WRD, and they have signed the

**PROGRESS:** The project has undergone various reconfigurations in

response to evolving concerns and desires of local residents. Current preferred alternative will involve both

the construction of a levee to be coordinated with

roadway grade raises. A Preliminary Engineering Report has been prepared and the project can be taken to the voters for consideration once Lincoln Township has

accrued sufficient funding.

PROJECT NAME: McDowell Dam Downstream Re-Zoning McDowell Dam was designed and constructed as a PROBLEM: medium hazard dam. Downstream development could raise the hazard classification to 'high' which could necessitate extensive modifications and public expense in order to comply with heightened dam design standards. Dear Chairman Fleck and Board Members:

My review of our contract with the Burleigh County Water Resource District indicates that our two year agreement ended as of January 1, 2015. I understand that the District's other administrative contracts are for single year durations and I will propose the same.

Enclosed please find a proposed hourly fee agreement between Bliss & Stebbins Law Firm, LLC and the Burleigh County Water Resource District. Our discounted hourly rates in this proposed agreement have increased by 7.5%, but still represent the same 19 % discount from my standard hourly rate of \$275 for civil litigation. My hourly discounted fee will increase to \$231 per hour from the present \$215 per hour; my partner Jackie's hourly rate increases from \$188 to \$202; my associate Mike Mulloy's hourly rate increases from \$161 to \$173; and our legal assistant hourly rate for our two legal assistants will be billed at one half of my new hourly rate, or \$115.50. Also included in this fee agreement is the provision which provides for the \$1,000 flat fee I shall receive for each monthly meeting.

It is my privilege to serve the District as your counsel, and I thank you for the opportunity to do so. Please let me know if you have questions.

The Burleigh County Water District ("District"), hereby retains Bliss & Stebbins Law Firm, LLC, 400 E. Broadway Avenue, Suite 308, P.O. Box 4126, Bismarck, ND 58502-4126, telephone (701) 223-5769, to represent the District with regard to the following matter: water board legal counsel.

- IT IS AGREED that time spent (attorneys fees) by the attorneys on this matter will be billed at the rate of \$231.00 per hour for David R. Bliss, \$202.00 per hour for Jackie M. Stebbins and \$173.00 per hour for Micheal A. Mulloy. Time spent by the legal assistants will be billed at a rate of \$115.50 per hour.
- ► IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the District will pay a \$1,000 flat fee to Bliss & Stebbins Law Firm, LLC for each monthly meeting.
- IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the District will receive from Bliss & Stebbins Law Firm, LLC, once per month, a billing statement itemizing fees and costs for the month.
- IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the District will pay, in full, all fees and costs which are billed for each month, and interest will be charged at the rate of 18% annum for all fees not paid before the 25<sup>th</sup> of the following month.
- IT IS FURTHER AGREED that either the District or counsel may withdraw from this agreement at any time with proper notice given to the other party.

"Costs" are, unless authorized by the District, limited to:

- 1. postage
- 2. substantial reproduction costs
- 3. expert witness fees
- 4. filing fees
- 5. travel expenses

Counsel will bill for all time spent on telephone conferences, office conferences, document preparation time, research time, and any other time spent on behalf of the client.

This contract will terminate January 1, 2016. For the duration of the contract, there will be no cost of living adjustments or other increases unless agreed to in writing between the parties.
