




Fox Island – Residence Flood Risk Map





2011 Flood Impacts 19.3 foot stage









Notice to Burleigh Water Resource Board and Houston Engineering:


WE, the undersigned residents of Fox Island who have lots in segment E and segment D where the proposed levee is to be built, wish to notify the Burleigh Water Resource Board and Houston Engineering, that as land owners along the Missouri River and the Fox Island Oxbow, we are against the proposed permanent dike project for flood protection on our lots. We do not feel that all the alternatives were adequately studied and we believe we were not given adequate representation on the Fox Island Flood Mitigation Steering Committee. We do believe that flood protection for Fox Island is important but since the process that you have undertaken and the decisions you have made were without our input, WE WILL NOT BE GRANTING EASEMENTS FOR THIS PROJECT. If efforts toward a permanent dike project continues and some members of Fox Island feel the dike proposal needs to proceed, and the vote results would end in favor of the permanent dike, it will require legal intervention to gain access to our property.






Selected Alternative – Design Completed



Roadway and Levee Segments




Typical Levee Section



Petition Language to the BCWRD


September 5, 2016

I (we) do hereby petition the Burleigh County Water Resource Board to reconsider the location of the proposed levee; that it not be placed on the top of Gallatin Loop, but instead, be built with an East – West direction, placed on the back yard property lines of specific lots located within Gallatin Loop west of Fontenelle Dr. and on the back yard property lines of specific lots located within Gallatin Loop, Far West Dr. east of Fontenelle Dr.

Note: Some petitioners lived south of Gallatin Drive and others owned lots to the North of the roadway.





Missouri River Levee Segment Realignment







Construction Related Issues

- Increase in Roadway Surface Elevation
 - 1.21 to 1.76 feet (varies by location)
- Phasing of Project
 - Currently Looking at 4 Phases (to limit inconvenience)
- Garbage/Mail/UPS-FedEx
 - Garbage Picked Up By Contractor Weekly
 - Temporary Mail Box Bank
 - UPS-FedEx May have to Pick Up from Local Store








- If a temporary construction easement is granted by the lot owner, all driveways will meet existing or better slopes paid for by the project.
- All driveways will allow for a vehicle access without bottoming out per the NCHRP Report 659: Guide for the Geometric Design of Driveways.
- Landowners have a choice to participate or not. We have attempted to contact everyone, but can't make you sign the easement.
