City of Bismarck Tom Baker Room Public Meeting Guidelines

Assumptions

- Guidance as of 5/18/20 from CDC, State of ND, and City of Bismarck. Proposed guidelines for May 18, 2020 may need to be reviewed and updated accordingly if CDC/NDDOH/Bismarck guidance is modified.
- Guidance created specifically for City of Bismarck hosted meetings but would be applicable to other political subdivisions and Boards utilizing the space.
- Boards with 5 or less members could attend in person and be seated at the head table. Boards with more than 5 members would require virtual participation or would need to be seated in the "media" table or "staff support table" in order to maintain 6' separation.

Guidelines

- Stars are marked at the head table for where each of 5 people can sit. The side tables can accommodate 2 individuals distanced each. Any numbers exceeding this in a Commission must attend virtually.
- Attendees and Staff are encouraged to use alternative methods to attending meeting such as conference calls, video conferencing or providing comments to Board Members prior to the meeting.
- ND Smart Restart should be posted in a conspicuous location outside the building and outside meeting room.
- Lines and waiting areas (indoor or outdoor) should be marked so physical distancing standards are met.
- Standing in the entry area should be minimized by encouraging attendees to quickly access their seats.
- Overflow seating should be provided on first floor conference room if capacity of the Tom Baker Room is fully used.
- Hand sanitizer should be offered to attendees as they arrive in the building and into the meeting room.
- Chairs for attendees should be spaced to allow 6 feet of separation for all attendees. Attendees should be instructed not to move chairs. Gallery occupancy is 34 seated individuals in chairs.
- Attendees should be encouraged to wear cloth masks where social distancing cannot be easily maintained.
- High frequency touched surfaced such as railings, door handles, and tables should be cleaned and disinfected before and after each meeting.
- Podium used by Attendees
 - Provide hand sanitizer at the podium.
 - Attendee should say and spell their name in lieu of signing in.
 - Clean and disinfect the podium before and after each meeting.

Dear Mr. Fender:

My law office represents the Burleigh County Water Resource District ("the District"). The District has asked me to reply to your June 11, 2020 email request for information to District Executive Secretary Tracie Day. You have requested the following information:

What I am requesting is for any notice that was given to the prior owner, Bob Upgren, on the property 2100 Far West Drive, Bismarck, North Dakota 58504 regarding the proposed [levee] work that would be done out here in Fox Island. The voting petition, or any notices that would have been given. This would have been in the year 2017 or prior. Any information such as this would be very helpful regarding the flood [plain] project that was just completed out here.

The Fox Island project began in 2009 and has an extensive record of documents. As a result, the District has attempted to tailor your request to those documents and correspondence which were mailed to Mr. Upgren prior to and including all such documents and correspondence for the year 2017. The District notes that Mr. Upgren's name was not found on the District's public informational meeting signup sheets for the project. These records have not been provided because Mr. Upgren's name was not found on such attendance lists. Dear Mr. Peterson:

The Burleigh County Water Resource District (District) received your second request for assessment reconsideration regarding the Fox Island Flood Control Project. The following are our responses to your questions.

1. "The project vote was approved by an 79.8% to 20.2% margin." How was that calculated? The figures imply that there were 500 votes. Were these votes based on the same basis used for assessment, namely one vote per lot? Or was another method?

Voting is based on one vote for each \$1 of assessment, which was documented in the ballots provided. Attached is a summary of the recorded vote tally; understand that not everyone took the opportunity to vote and that a "simple majority" of those who voted was necessary to approve the project.

2. The assessment "was based on a uniform distribution of benefits". How were benefits of this project determined? My lots are worth a small fraction of those home owners affected by the 500 year event in 2011. Separate from protection from another flood, the resale value of those properties is significantly improved by this project. Meanwhile, homes built on my lots will have little risk of flood damage, because of the many thousands of dollars of fill required to keep those theoretical homes above flood levels. Or, will the assessment district pay for "flood control" for those homes?

Every residential lot has the same potential for development, whether an empty lot or one with a \$200,000 or a \$1 Million residence, this did not influence the assessment. Each property is provided the same level of flood protection or benefit; therefore, the value of a residence or lack thereof was not a consideration. Most, if not all, residential lots in this development required fill to be imported, this burden is assumed by the owner and varies by lot.

3. "Your lots are not unlike others within the assessment district that all have the same assessment." Really!? My lots have no homes. My lots required no significant mitigation. The lots received no enhancements. Neither lot has a current or planned structure below current flood related building codes.

Again, the flood protection provided each lot is equal regardless as to what exists or may exist in the future on a subject property. All assessed lots are developable as rural residential property, and as you noted while some are developed others are not. The BCWRD assigned these values uniformly and does not change assessments each time an owner elects to modify conditions on their property with a new structure, secondary structure or other improvement. Not unlike a roadway assessment the benefit provided to each property for access, in this case flood control, is the same. All improvements in place today or future construction are equally protected and therefore assessed the same. While the full flood control benefits provided may or may not be realized until a later date, they exist none the less. Anyone constructing on your lots is provided the same flood protection as any other lot within the protected area.

4. "Their undeveloped status does not influence the benefits provided versus others that are developed." I apologize. I'm not sure I understand that sentence correctly, but on its face, it is patently absurd.

All lots were assessed the same based on the equal level of flood protection provided to each. This level of protection is the same regardless of the residential structures value, or lack thereof, and if the structure is above or below the floodplain, has a basement or is slab on grade construction.

5. I know that at the end of the day you have a project to pay for, but please reconsider adjusting my assessment. I hope you can see beyond legal defensibilities and past victories on this project and act in the spirit of fairness.

The Board appreciates the questions, but the response is unchanged, your assessments will not be reconsidered.
