# **Tom Baker Room Public Meeting Guidelines**

### **Assumptions**

- Guidance as of 5/18/20 from CDC, State of ND, and City of Bismarck. Proposed guidelines for May 18, 2020 may need to be reviewed and updated accordingly if CDC/NDDOH/Bismarck guidance is modified.
- Guidance created specifically for City of Bismarck hosted meetings but would be applicable to other political subdivisions and Boards utilizing the space.
- Boards with 5 or less members could attend in person and be seated at the head table. Boards with more than 5
  members would require virtual participation or would need to be seated in the "media" table or "staff support
  table" in order to maintain 6' separation.

### Guidelines

- Stars are marked at the head table for where each of 5 people can sit. The side tables can accommodate 2 individuals distanced each. Any numbers exceeding this in a Commission must attend virtually.
- Attendees and Staff are encouraged to use alternative methods to attending meeting such as conference calls,
   video conferencing or providing comments to Board Members prior to the meeting.
- ND Smart Restart signs should be posted in a conspicuous location outside the building and outside meeting room.
- Lines and waiting areas (indoor or outdoor) should be marked so physical distancing standards are met.
- Standing in the entry area should be minimized by encouraging attendees to quickly access their seats.
- Overflow seating should be provided on first floor conference room if capacity of the Tom Baker Room is fully used.
- Hand sanitizer should be offered to attendees as they arrive in the building and into the meeting room.
- Chairs for attendees should be spaced to allow 6 feet of separation for all attendees. Attendees should be instructed not to move chairs. Gallery occupancy is 34 seated individuals in chairs.
- Attendees should be encouraged to wear cloth masks where social distancing cannot be easily maintained.
- High frequency touched surfaced such as railings, door handles, and tables should be cleaned and disinfected before and after each meeting.

### Abstract/Executive Summary

### Abstract/Executive Summary\*:

The Burleigh County Water Resource District (BCWRD) intends to proactively stabilize a portion of the shoreline of the McDowell Dam Reservoir to prevent continued erosion, the potential loss a valuable recreational resource and further degradation of the natural habitat. The project will also relocate a portion of recreational trail to be farther away from the water's edge and protected from loss in the event of shoreline erosion. In addition, a culvert will be added and another culvert will be removed and replaced with a new culvert in two locations where concentrated surface runoff crosses the pedestrian trail and has degraded the trail quality.

This project will accomplish key objectives by preserving and improving an important feature of a parks and recreation facility in our community. Protecting the east shoreline with riprap and using natural soil stabilization measures, where practical, will prevent further bank erosion and protect against a potential slope failure of the adjacent property. This failure would result in the loss of a primary trail segment along the pedestrian trail system and significant environmental impacts to the McDowell Dam Reservoir.

The project will provide both bank stability and stabilization of the natural areas that are eroding. Stabilization of the east shoreline will maintain the slope and maintain water quality in the reservoir. Trees will be planted to augment the riprap bank stabilization and provide additional shoreline habitat and slope stability for potentially erodible areas.

The BCWRD considered an alternative trail location, should a significant slope failure occur in this area. Unfortunately, the only suitable location would require the acquisition of additional land from the adjacent landowner. Due to the reluctance of the adjacent property owner to sell and the associated cost to purchase the property, the proposed project is a more viable alternative. Therefore, this project will allow BCWRD to maintain the trail in its current location with positive impacts on the McDowell Dam Reservoir and protecting the natural areas within its boundaries.

The Burleigh County Water Resource District (BCWRD) has a five-member Board of Commissioners, including a Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary/Treasurer and two Managers.

The Burleigh County Water Resource District was the original local sponsor for the construction of McDowell Dam by the NCRCS. In accordance with the project agreement, the BCWRD is now the owner of the project and is responsible for maintenance and operation throughout a projected 50 year project life.

### Purpose of Grant\*:

The project?s goal is to be proactive and restore, protect and maintain the lake shoreline, to prevent further degradation and increased risks for slope failure. This in turn will protect the existing McDowell Dam trail system circumnavigating the McDowell Dam Reservoir as well as enhance existing park facilities. Preventing further erosion will improve water quality, soil conditions, and provide stable habitat along the shoreline. The portion of trail that is affected is part of a shared use path system and provides a continuous route around the lake. The proactive nature of this project seeks to repair current erosion and stop it from progressing to a point where a major slope failure could occur and the repair will be more damaging and costly. The grant funding would help to preserve and protect the trail environment and lake water quality enjoyed by community residents.

Attachment A contains figures depicting a preliminary design layout. Utilizing both natural and manmade products, the shoreline of the McDowell Dam Reservoir will be protected and natural vegetation reestablished on eroded areas and those disturbed by construction.

The increased rate of erosion in this area is a function of several factors. The exposed eastern shoreline with significant wave action experienced during prevailing northwest wind is the first factor. The proposed project area is critical due to the steep nature of the uphill slope to the east. This project also will improve the habitat quality along the trail system, as well as water quality in the adjacent recreational lake. Protecting and restoring habitat will attract birds and animals to the area for residents and visitors to enjoy while utilizing the provided facilities.

The proposed project will take an innovative approach by considering both hard (riprap) and soft (vegetation) stabilization measures and applying them where they best provide the intended purpose.

North Dakota Administrative Code § 89-08-01-01 defines "other device" as "a water control structure, other than a dam or dike, including diversions and holding ponds, lagoons, or dugouts."

### DRAINAGE COMPLAINTS (N.D.C.C. § 61-32-07):

Surface Drainage: The District will determine if a landowner or tenant constructed any surface drainage that impacts a watershed area of 80 acres or more without first securing a drainage permit as required under N.D.C.C. § 61-32-03, or in conflict with the terms or conditions of a drainage permit.

Tile Drainage: The District will determine if a landowner or tenant constructed or installed a tile or subsurface drainage system with a footprint of 80 acres or more without first securing a tile or subsurface permit as required under N.D.C.C. § 61-32-03.1, or in conflict with the terms or conditions of a tile or subsurface permit.

### OBSTRUCTION TO DRAIN COMPLAINTS (N.D.C.C. § 61-16.1-51):

The District will determine if a landowner or tenant has intentionally or negligently caused an obstruction to a natural watercourse or drain.

The District must act pursuant to the appropriate code listed above. The District shall investigate and make a determination within a reasonable amount of time (not to exceed 120 days for dams, dikes, other devices, or drains). The District shall notify all parties of its decision as required by code. If complained of activity was a dam, dike, other device, or drain, the District's decision may be appealed to the State Engineer within 30 days of the District's decision. If the complained of activity was an obstruction to drain, the District's decision may be appealed to District Court.

This shifts the scope of services from the BCHD back to the BCWRD as part of the revised design features. Therefore, the BCWRD budget will need to be increased to accommodate that change. These costs may be offset in part by eliminating the Apple Creek modeling, but the extent remains to be determined. This does not influence the State Water Commission Cost Share submittal only who pays for these services.
- Discussions with the USACE regarding project development was productive and set the stage for future meeting notices to comply with the NEPA review process. The Section 408 process will require an Environmental Assessment, which will occur with final design and permitting.
